Smith, Infant born March 3, 1900 died March 3, 1900. dau. of V.E. & O.L. Smith

Jackson, M.O. Co. K 3rd W. Va. Cav. a Government marker.

(This is Marion Orlando, son of Henry & Elizabeth (Shreves) Jackson. He was born July 14, 1841 died Jan. 14, 1892. husband of Columbia Dean Jackson)

Jackson, Melvin W. born 1834 died 1900 son of M.O. Jackson and

Barb, Clipso E(Elizabeth) Jackson b. Oct. 11, 1877 died March 6, 1918. wife of G.C. Barb. Daughter of Samuel Dexter & Elizabeth Martha (Marple) Jackson

Jackson, Myrtle(Ann) b. Feb. 16, 1873 died Feb. 10, 1916. dau. of Dexter & Martha

Jackson, Martha E(Elizabeth) b. July 21, 1846 died Aug. 1, 1914 wid. of Sam. Dexter Jackson (dau. of Moses & Elizabeth(?) Bennett Marple Jackson.

Jackson, Samuel Dexter, Co. H. 3rd W.Va. Cav. Government marker.

born July 28, 1838 died Nov. 5, 1911. son of Henry & Elizabeth (Shreves) Jackson (husband of Martha E. (Marple) Jackson)

Jackson, James Alonza Co. H. 3rd W. Va. Cav. Government.

(died at Harper's Ferry) born May 2, 1840 died 1864. (son of Henry & Elizabeth (Shreves) Jackson)

There are 9 marked graves and 13 unmarked ones. From members of the family and from death and birth records, I can place 10 of the 13. (Beatrice A. Giffin)

Jackson, Mary Hire(b. June 4, 1874 died Jan. 17, 1835. First wife of Henry Jackson Ester

Jackson, Esta (?) born Mar. 31, 1801 died June 27, 1835 daughter of Henry and Mary (Hire) Jackson.

These two graves should have been under the two coffin shaped tombstones, according to Columbus Jackson, in 1935. He is a grandson of Henry and Elizabeth (Shreves) Jackson and says these tombstones were placed here shortly after Henry's second marriage.

Jackson, Henry b. either June or July 10, 1774 died Feb. 24, 1852 (his first wife was Mary Hire and his second wife was Elizabeth Shreves. He was the youngest son of John and Elizabeth (Cummins) Jackson

Jackson, Jacob b. Oct. 27, 1821 died Feb. 27, 1823. son of Henry and Mary(Hire) Jackson

Jackson, Clipso Verio b. Jan. 15, 1848 died Oct. 21, 1852 dau. of Henry & Elizabeth (Shreves) Jackson.

Jackson, George Washington Oct. 17, 1845 died Dec. 7, 1853 son of Henry & Elizabeth (According to Roy Bird Cook, on pg. 15 of his book, (Shreves) Jackson. "The Family and Early Life of Stonewall Jackson, he says that George Washington Jackson was killed by Indians while crossing the plains). This sounds as if he went out west. He would only have been 8 years old.

Jackson, Melissa born March 19, 1842 died 1857 dau of Henry & Elizabeth(Shreves, Jackson.

Jackson, Columbia Roxana born Nov. 29, 1844 died Jan. 20, 1845. dau. Henry & E.(Shreves) Jackson.

Jackson, John died when abt 2 years of age. son of Dexter and Martha(Marple) Jackson.

Have been told that Elizabeth(Shreves) Jackson(who later married Sam Sayre, is also buried here.
